
OPIKAR Furniture was created in 2024 with the acquisition of a local company (TIMO Furniture founded in 1996).

HOUSE MRAZ

Arhitekti Počivašek Petranovič have created a two-story residential house in the vicinity of Celje, which blends beautifully with the green surroundings and resembles a glass pavilion. The reflective surfaces of the upper floor's facade allow the house to become a part of nature, while the large glass areas ensure a seamless connection between the interior and the exterior, offering a stunning view of the nearby orchard and Celje Castle.

Our team custom-made all the furniture for this house. On the ground floor, there are three wooden service boxes - a bathroom, a toilet, and a wardrobe - with sliding doors that allow the space to open up into a large, unified area or to be divided into individual rooms as needed. All visible parts of these boxes are clad in American walnut veneer, finished with a matte lacquer. In the kitchen, where wooden elements intertwine with black grooves, there is a large kitchen island set on two cubes and made of stainless steel, adding a modern and elegant touch to the space.









In collaboration with Studio Tina Rugelj, we designed and furnished a stunning apartment in a multiapartment building in Ljubljana. Spanning approximately 130 m² across two floors, the apartment is connected by a central wooden staircase, adding an elegant and refined touch to the home.

The interior design is open and bright, with wooden accents creating a cozy and homely atmosphere. The furniture is crafted from premium materials, featuring painted MDF in warm, earthy tones, complemented by laminate in light and oak decor, textile coverings, and solid oak wood accents. These carefully selected elements achieve a perfect balance between functionality and aesthetics, making this apartment uniquely attractive and comfortable for living.

A HOUSE FOR FIVE AND A WORLD OF FRIENDS

In the residential complex Poljansko nabrežje on Mesarska Street in Ljubljana, we crafted furniture and interior doors for an apartment according to the plans of the architects Počivašek Petranovič. During the renovation, the architects expanded the living area by incorporating balconies, providing the apartment with more light and spaciousness. The spatial design and layout of the equipment are open and functional, with plenty of room for plants.

The interior design features predominantly white shades, with painted MDF as the primary material. The kitchen island, which extends into the dining table, is made of oak veneer. The cabinets in the kitchen niche, hidden behind tall folding doors, are made of bleached birch plywood. The countertop with the sink and the wall covering is made of stainless steel.










Designed by architect Matej Gašperič, this wooden house in Logatec is tailored for an active and sociable family of five, surrounded by meadows and forests. The structure is laid out in two parallel volumes across three levels, including a semi-underground basement. The home covers 210 m² of usable space featuring four bedrooms, two bathrooms, a sauna, a fitness room, a spacious office, a large living-kitchen area, two terraces, a garage, a utility room, and a storage room. We furnished the entire house, opting for furniture in white and anthracite tones that complement the bright, naturally lit spaces surrounded by light wood. This design creates a warm, inviting, and functional living environment that enhances family interaction and active living.









In the heart of Ljubljana, in collaboration with the architectural firm Dekleva Gregorič architects, we co-created the furnishings for office spaces. Designed solution leverages curtains to offer flexibility and versatile usability to the open floor plan. We manufactured all the built-in equipment, including interior doors, fitted cabinets, closets and the kitchen. The predominant material is painted MDF, which gives the space a warm and contemporary look, while the kitchen countertop is made of stainless steel, chosen for its durability and clean aesthetic. This concept combines functionality and aesthetic appeal, with each element contributing to the overall image and efficiency of the work environment.









The holiday home in the vicinity of Lake Bohinj represents a symbiosis of modern design and respect for the natural environment and local heritage. Built on the foundations of its predecessor, it adheres to strict environmental regulations that guide its shape and material selection. The facade, made of wooden panel construction, equipped with sliding parts, allows for complete integration with the surrounding nature by concealing or revealing windows, doors, and the ground-floor terrace as needed.

We have crafted furniture for the entire house using high-quality materials such as ultrapas and painted MDF in light tones, along with bleached oak veneer used for accents. This combination of materials creates a bright, airy, and inviting interior that reflects the purity and simplicity of the surrounding nature while also bringing a sense of warmth and homeliness.










In Ljubljana, we collaborated with Bevk Perović architects to furnish the renovated house on Koblarjeva Street. The property spans three floors, which were redesigned and interconnected during the renovation to create a dynamic living environment. The interior design showcases bright and open living spaces with modern furniture that beautifully complements the rough, colorful plasters, visible concrete parts, and a carefully renovated wooden staircase. The kitchen boasts stainless steel elements that provide a modern and industrial look, while the benches and room furniture made from bonded plywood of Brazilian pine ensure durability and warmth of the material. The white elements are made of laminate and painted MDF material, together creating a thoughtful and aesthetically refined living environment.









The architects followed tradition and designed a compact single-family house that, in its form and choice of materials, reflects traditional local architecture, while also being technologically advanced and adapted to the needs of modern living. The house in Vrhovlje, with an area of 92 square meters, externally acts as a stone gabled monolith, into which two wooden volumes are inserted, interconnected by a bridge. On the ground floor are located the kitchen, dining room, and bathroom, while the first floor houses the bedroom and children's room.

The external appearance of the house is shaped by concrete and stone, while the interior uses wood, metal, and textiles. We furnished the entire interior, including wall claddings, interior doors, and stairs. The predominant material is bleached three-layer spruce wood, combined with smaller segments of painted MDF for built-in wardrobes and matte black laminate in the kitchen.

SILENT REVOLUTIONS; CONTEMPORARY DESIGN IN SLOVENIA



Following the plans of the Bevk Perović arhitekti, we furnished a single-family residential house in Bežigrad, Ljubljana, situated on a smaller plot with a lawn. The exterior of the house is defined by a modern, anthracite aluminum cladding, providing a contemporary and elegant appearance. In contrast, the interior reveals an opposite approach - the spaces are designed to be open, with large areas and abundant natural light, creating a sense of spaciousness and freshness. The interior design prominently features the use of painted MDF, adding warmth and a homely feel to the spaces. Highlight materials such as white Kerrock for the kitchen island countertop, ensuring durability and easy maintenance, and laminate stairs (hpl) have been chosen for their emphasis on functionality and as visual elements in the space.









The exhibition "Silent Revolutions: Contemporary Design in Slovenia," first presented in London in 2011, highlighted the significance of Slovenian product design on the international stage. The works of more than 25 designers showcased the first two decades of development and innovation in independent Slovenia. The exhibition was later also presented in other foreign locations (Netherlands, Italy, Austria, Russia, etc.).

For the execution of the exhibition, multifunctional transport elements were created that also served as display settings. Materials such as birch plywood and solid pine ensured quality and durability. White bases made from painted MDF and plexiglass covers added a modern visual contrast and provided protection for the displayed items. Pallet bases and larger boxes facilitated the proper presentation of larger exhibits. After the exhibitions, all elements were meticulously refurbished, extending their lifespan and preserving their visual impact.

The interior features a blend of materials including wood, glass, and textiles.
